SEVA ONLINE VIDEO CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Contest period: Contest is open to Canadian citizens or permanent residents. Contest void where prohibited by law. Contest open to participants 13 years and older. Contest will close December 15th, 2009 at 11:59pm PST. Contest winners will be announced during the first week of February, 2010.

Video requirements: Videos must not be longer than 3 minutes in length. Only one submission per person will be considered. Videos must be in English or contain English subtitles. Submission must adhere to the theme of gender and blindness. Submissions will be judged on style, creativity, uniqueness and relevance to topic.

Releases and consents: By entering the contest, each entrant – with the consent of a parent or guardian in the case of those under 18 years of age – consents to the use, reproduction, publication, transmission and/or broadcasting of his/her name and/or likeness. Contestants acknowledge Seva Canada's ownership of all copyrights and other intellectual property rights in the submitted videos, and Seva Canada's right to utilize submitted video, in whole or in part, for any purpose, including publicity and advertising, without compensation.

Original work: Submissions will be void if there is presence of any copyrighted material that is not in the public domain or for which you have not obtained the rights to use. Submission may not incur any third party agreements, additionally, third party voice-overs for which you have not obtained the rights to use is prohibited. Third party stock photography or artwork which you have not obtained rights to use is not allowed. Videos should contain nothing illegal, lewd or loathsome. With respect to videos submitted to YouTube, submissions must meet all guidelines and criteria imposed by YouTube. Failure to adhere to regulations could result in disqualification.

Group submissions: If a submission is made by a group, a team leader must be named and, if the group wins, the named team leader will be the recipient of any prizes.

Personal information: Submissions become property of Seva who then reserves the right to use names, photographs and video submissions for promotion purposes.

No responsibility: Seva Canada reserves the right to change or modify contest rules, dates, judging panel and criteria at any time, without notice. Seva is in no way responsible for contestant exposure to other YouTube content. Any entries that are lost, late, damaged or unable to be viewed due to technical error will be void. In the event of a dispute regarding submission of an online entry, the entry will be deemed submitted by the authorized holder of the email account.
